Dementia / Antipsychotic Audit*	<p>The practice will be required to:</p> <p>a) Audit the repeat prescribing of antipsychotic medications for patients over the age of 65, diagnosed with dementia (in the absence of a definitive SMI diagnosis) who are a resident in a care home</p> <p>and</p> <p>b) Review the prescribing of risperidone and olanzapine in care home patients aged over 65, suffering from dementia, who have received one of these drugs for more than 12 weeks. (audit template from PCT Prescribing Team to follow)</p> <p><i>NB Atypical antipsychotic drugs are associated with a 3 fold increase in the risk of stroke in elderly patients with dementia. Therapy should not generally be considered beyond 12 weeks.</i></p>	6	N/A	1 point

Adverse Drug Reactions	<p>a) Practice to submit a quarterly report to the PCT on the number of yellow cards for black triangle drugs reported to MHRA by your practice.</p> <p>and</p> <p>b) Practice to submit a quarterly report to the PCT on number of yellow card reports of known significant side effects in non black triangle drugs reported to MHRA by your practice.</p> <p>and</p> <p>c) Practice to submit a quarterly report to the PCT on the number of new drug intolerances recorded in the practice system between 1st April 2008 and 31st March 2009</p> <p>(audit templates from PCT Prescribing Team to follow)</p>	3	N/A	1 point
